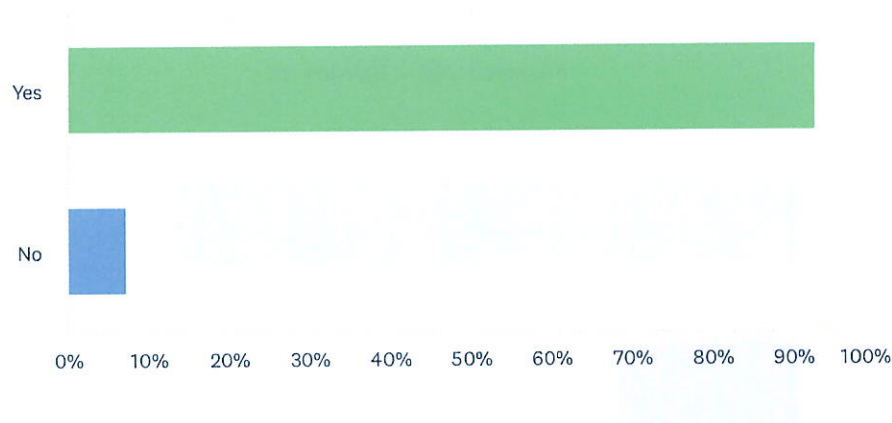


PROPOSAL TO CHARGE FOR PARKING AT BLAKENEY VILLAGE HALL CAR PARK - Blakeney Parish

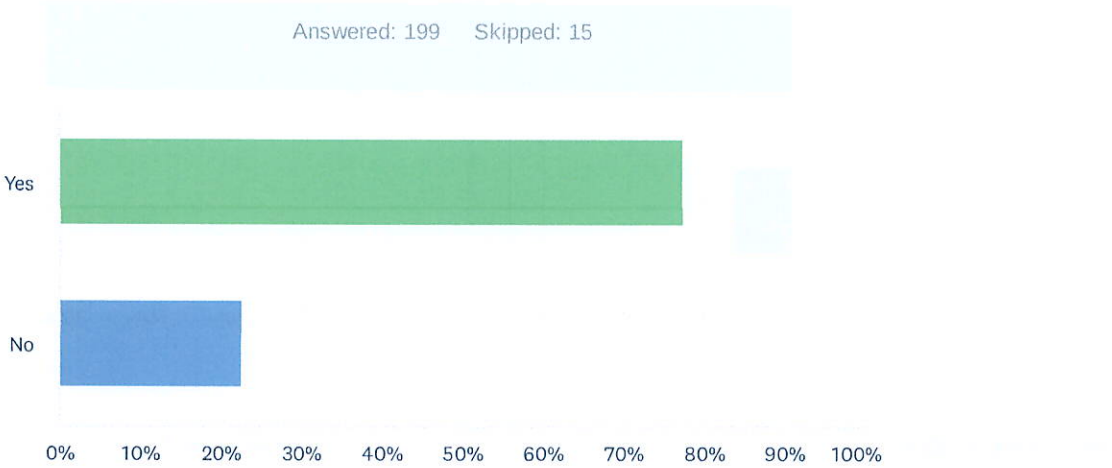

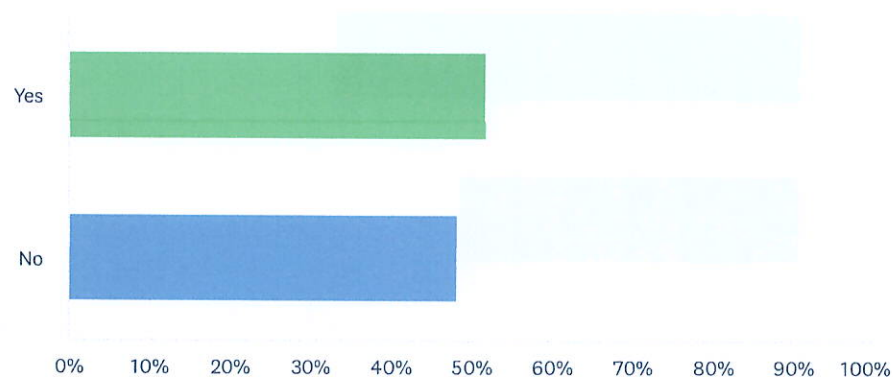

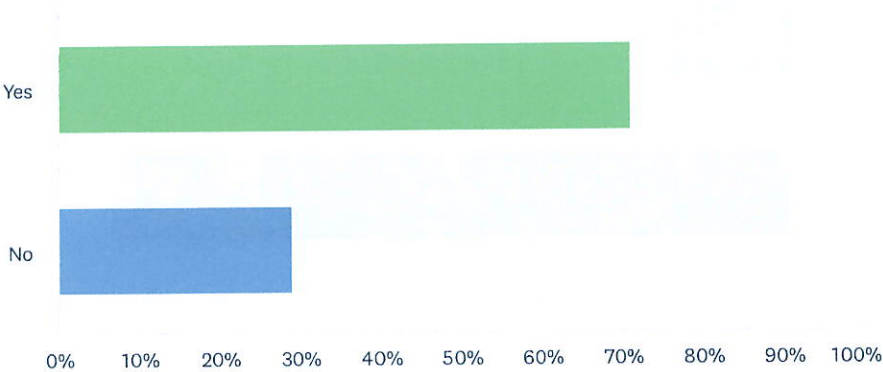

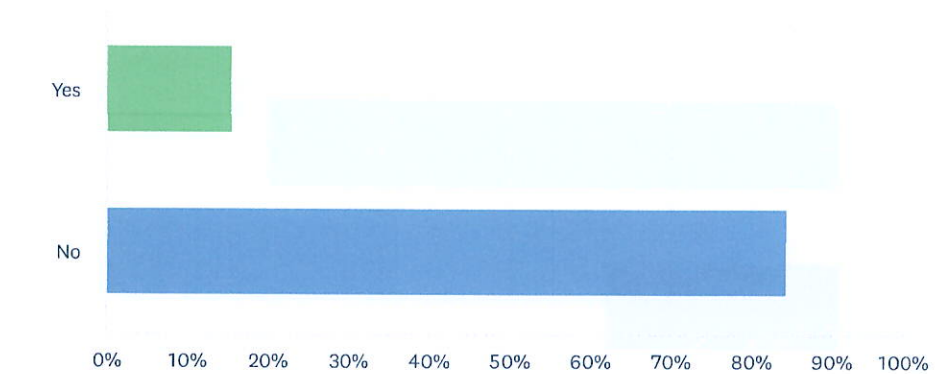

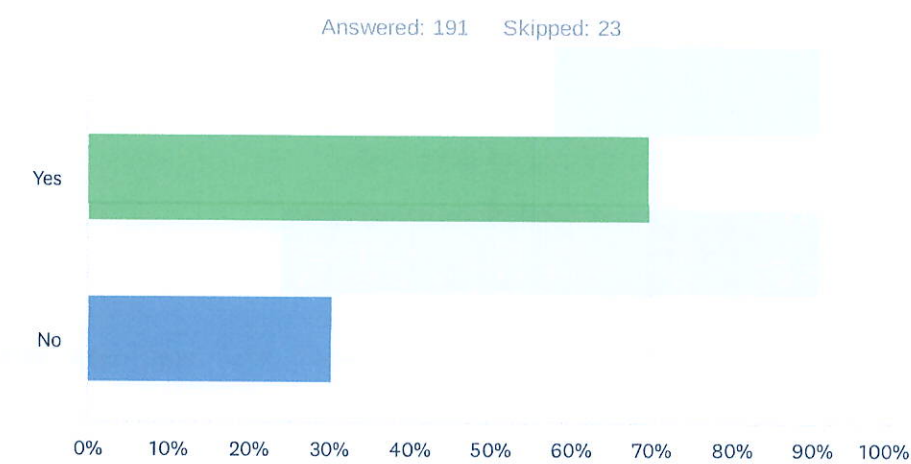
Q7 Should those who work in Blakeney and that are not Blakeney residents pay a fair price for an annual permit for the Village Hall car park.

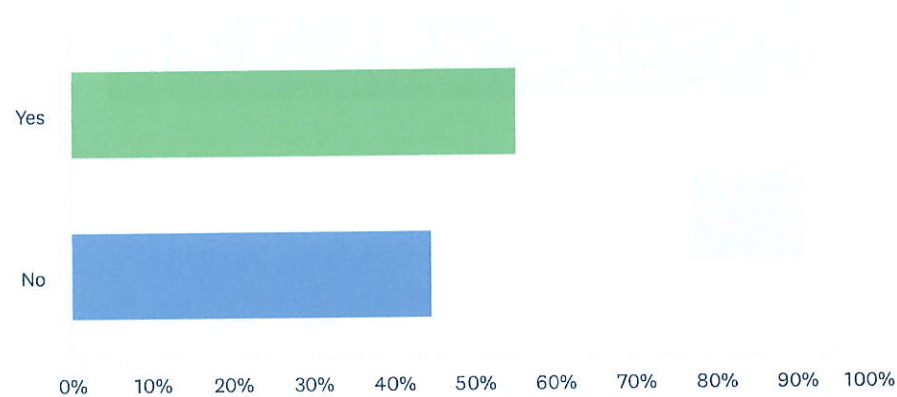

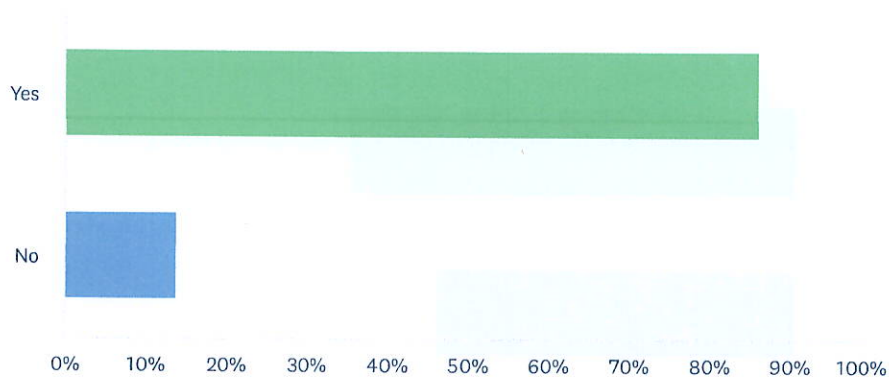
